Thanks for your interest in Cayman Islands Sailing Club. The following is a brief synopsis of the privileges of Membership:-

Sailing lessons

Sailing lessons are available for all ability levels – **Adult Learn to Sail** courses can be arranged for a group at favourable rates for an eight hour course. The current rates are published on the Clubs www.sailing.ky website.

Boat Rentals

Boat rentals are available at hourly rates in a number of different types of Club boats as follows:-

There are significant discounts offered for longer sailing sessions, such as a four hour session, a full day or a full weekend of sailing.

Please note that CISC boats are available for rent by qualified and experienced sailors, or those under direct instruction by the Club's coaches. Member rentals are subject to the terms of the Boat Rental Agreement contained in the Club's Code of Conduct. Non-Members are to complete a Non-Member Boat Rental Agreement in advance and will be required to provide either a valid credit card or a cash deposit before taking charge of the boat.

Racing and Crewing

The club holds numerous racing fixtures throughout the year for a wide range of sailing vessels. If you are interested in crewing or racing, please contact the appropriate fleet representative. Those persons can be found on www.sailing.ky. The regular racing fleets at CISC are the Dinghy Fleet, J22 Fleet and Cruiser Fleet.

J22 Crewing is occasionally available for social members or non-members. Contact the Fleet Representative for information. J22 Crewmembers who sail regularly, i.e. more than twice in any given year, are required to be a Full Member of the Club.

Dinghy Racing

Dinghy Racing is generally held on the 1st Sunday of each month. Boat Rental fees on race days may be discounted.

Newsletter

Members receive a periodic emailed newsletter, with a Commodore's Report, interim Financial Statements, general information about Club administration, race reports, notable other events and activities of members, a forward looking calendar and notices of upcoming sailing and social events.

Boat storage

The club offers boat and trailer storage facilities to full members at reasonable rates. Launch facilities are available during Operating Hours. Ask the Club Administrator or the Head Coach for details at admin@sailing.ky or coach@sailing.ky.

Social facilities and events

The club offers regular social events throughout the year such as the Commodores Cocktail Party, Guy Fawkes Family Night, Annual Ball, Wine & Jazz, Founder's Night, Pool and Karaoke Evenings etc. Sailing celebrity speakers join us from time to time. The Social Committee aims to arrange an event at least once a month and the Clubhouse is generally open on Friday evenings as well as all day for Saturday and Sunday post-sailing fellowship.

Kids Camps and Programs

Christmas, Summer, Easter and Half Term Camps, after school programs and racing lessons are available for children of all ages and ability levels. Camp pricing is published to members via email and also on the Club's website and other social media. Ask the Club Administrator or the Head Coach for details at booking@sailing.ky.

Clubhouse

Members in good standing have open account charge facilities at the Clubhouse Bar which runs on an honour system. Members are sent a Statement of their account activity at least monthly.
